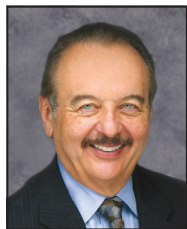

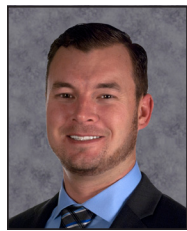

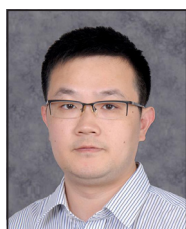

Historic First Strike Coinage from The Royal Mint

Offered in this exciting auction are the very first coins struck of the Lion and Eagle, Britannia and Liberty, Coronation Britannia, and Coronation gold and silver bullion series produced by The Royal Mint. These are significant for being among the first coins produced in the name of King Charles III, and they represent some of the most inspiring and innovative designs to emerge from The Royal Mint in modern times. They serve as tangible and captivating treasures marking this new chapter of British and world numismatics.

Presented are the first coins struck of the 2023 Coronation 1 oz Gold and Silver bullion coins, the 2023 Coronation Britannia 1 oz Gold and Silver bullion

coins, the 2024 Britannia and Liberty 1 oz Gold, ¼ oz Gold, and 1 oz Silver bullion coins, as well as the 2024 Lion and Eagle 1 oz Gold and Silver bullion coins.

This special series of first strike coinage will be offered across two live bidding sessions, and every coin will be presented individually. Each is also graded and encapsulated by leading grading service Numismatic Guaranty Company (“NGC”) with custom labels to recognize their historic significance. Coins of the highest significance will also feature labels with signatures from Royal Mint CEO Anne Jessopp and the King’s Assay Master Daniel Thomas.



THE 2023 CORONATION OF HIS MAJESTY KING CHARLES III GOLD AND SILVER BULLION COINS

The 2023 Coronation of King Charles III gold and silver bullion coins were specially produced to commemorate the historic coronation of His Majesty the King, which took place on May 6, 2023. The reverse features a bespoke design by John Bergdahl depicting King Charles III’s royal cypher, whilst the obverse features the first crowned coinage portrait of His Majesty the King, designed by Martin Jennings. This desirable and inspiring coinage issue is a fitting keepsake to mark such a historic event in British and World history. Offered in this special auction will be the first 150 struck of the 1 oz gold issue, as well as the first 250 struck of the 1 oz silver issue.

THE 2023 CORONATION BRITANNIA GOLD AND SILVER BULLION COINS



The 2023 Coronation Britannia gold and silver bullion coins represent a truly important rendition of one of the world’s most recognised and trusted bullion coins. Since their debut in 1987, the Britannia series has been sought after by investors and institutions for their innovative security features and designs. These special coins were struck to celebrate the coronation of His Majesty King Charles III and will be the only Britannia coins in history to feature the first crowned effigy of His Majesty King Charles III, designed by Martin Jennings. THE 2024 LION AND EAGLE GOLD AND SILVER BULLION COINS



The 2024 Lion and Eagle gold and silver bullion coins were created in a partnership between The Royal Mint and John M. Mercanti, Chief Engraver at the United States Mint from 2006 to 2010. This issue brings together two national icons, the British Lion and the American Eagle, in one inspiring composition. Mercanti’s reverse design features bold renditions of these powerful symbols which convey the courage, strength and freedom embodied by their respective nations. The obverse design features the coinage portrait of His Majesty King Charles III by The Royal Mint artist Martin Jennings. This historic coin series represents the shared values and enduring relationship between the United Kingdom and the United States, nations which so often stand together in solidarity. Offered in this special auction will be the first 150 struck of the 1 oz gold issue as well as the first 250 struck of the 1 oz silver issue.

THE 2024 BRITANNIA AND LIBERTY GOLD AND SILVER BULLION COINS



The 2024 Britannia and Liberty gold and silver bullion coins were borne of a historic collaboration between The Royal Mint and the United States Mint. Gordon Summers and Joseph Menna, the respective Chief Engravers of each mint, collaborated on a coin for the first time, crafting a design that unites the national symbols of Britannia and Liberty. As such, they serve as a physical representation of the ‘special relationship’ – a phrase coined by Sir Winston Churchill in 1946 – shared between the United Kingdom and the United States. Inspired by the designs of playing cards, Britannia and Liberty share equal prominence in this masterfully crafted design that exemplifies the skill and experience of each Chief Engraver. The figures also represent fortitude and freedom, virtues that underpin the national identities of both the United Kingdom and the United States. Offered in this special auction will be the first 150 struck of the 1 oz and ¼ oz gold issues, as well as the first 250 struck of the 1 oz silver issue.

His Majesty King Charles III

King of the United Kingdom from September 8, 2022 to Present

King Charles III was born on November 14, 1948, in London, England. He is the eldest son of the late Queen Elizabeth II and Prince Philip, Duke of Edinburgh.

In his youth, King Charles III attended various schools in the United Kingdom and later went on to study at Gordonstoun School in Scotland. He pursued further education at the University of Cambridge and the University of Wales, where he studied archaeology and anthropology.

King Charles III has been involved in numerous charitable endeavors, has advocated for various causes and in 1976 established The Prince's Trust, an organi-

zation dedicated to supporting young people in education, training, and employment. Additionally, he has been an active supporter of environmental conservation and sustainable development, founding The Prince's Rainforests Project in 2007. Even prior to his ascension on September 8, 2022, King Charles III had taken on various official duties and roles on behalf of the British monarchy. Having been heir apparent since the age of three, King Charles III is now the oldest monarch ever crowned in British history and brings to his sovereignty a lifetime of experience and wisdom to guide Britain into the future.

The Royal Mint

The Royal Mint, with its origins dating back over a thousand years, holds a significant place in the annals of coinage. It ranks as the United Kingdom's oldest continually operating company and the second oldest mint in the world. Its establishment can be traced to the reign of Alfred the Great in the late 9th century when a mint was set up in London. However, it was not until 1279 that The Royal Mint was officially recognized and granted its charter by King Edward I.

Initially located within the Tower of London, The Royal Mint played a crucial role in producing coins for the realm and maintaining the integrity of the currency. Over the centuries, it expanded and moved to various locations within London, including the Mint in the Tower, The Royal Mint Court, and the current state-of-the-art facility in South Wales.

Throughout its history, The Royal Mint has been at the forefront of coinage innovation. In the 16th century, the introduction of the screw press at the Mint revolutionized coin production, enabling higher volumes and greater consistency. Later, steam-powered machinery and advancements in metallurgy further enhanced efficiency and quality.

The Royal Mint has also been responsible for establishing and refining coin standards. The 1816 Coinage Act introduced the gold standard, which ensured that gold coins contained a specified amount of pure gold. In 1971, the Mint played a vital role in decimalizing the British currency, marking a significant milestone in the nation's monetary system.

In addition to producing circulating coins, The Royal Mint has a long tradition of crafting commemorative and ceremonial coins. These special issues celebrate important events, anniversaries, and national achievements. Notable examples include commemorative coins for the Olympics, royal weddings, and historical milestones.

Today, The Royal Mint continues to combine centuries-old craftsmanship with cutting-edge technology. It is renowned for its commitment to excellence, producing coins of exceptional quality and design. With its rich heritage, The Royal Mint remains a symbol of British numismatic expertise and the legacy of a minting institution that has shaped the nation's currency for centuries.

Anne Jessopp, CEO of The Royal Mint. Since joining The Royal Mint in 2008, Anne Jessopp has held several positions on the Board, including HR Director and Director of Consumer, before stepping into the role of CEO in 2018—the first female in the 1,100 year history of The Royal Mint to do so. Spearheading the transformation of one of the United Kingdom’s oldest businesses, Anne’s leadership of The Royal Mint has seen her introduce an ambitious strategy to continue to grow the consumer facing divisions, helping to safeguard the business and employment for the future. As a result, The Royal Mint is now firmly delivering its strategy of reinvention, while retaining its unique heritage as The Original Maker of beautiful and authentic products and services. Also under Anne’s leadership, The Royal Mint has committed to becoming a leader in sustainable precious metals.

Daniel Thomas, Assay Master for King Charles III. Daniel Thomas was appointed as the King’s Assay Master in September 2023 following nearly a decade at The Royal Mint in other roles including Engineer, Technical Manager, Operations Manager and Head of Operations. As Assay Master, he emphasized that “Each coin is a celebration of His Majesty, King Charles III. We are committed to ensuring our nation’s coinage is underpinned by the quality, accuracy, and excellence for which The Royal Mint is famous.”

The Designers

Gordon Summers. Gordon Summers, Chief Engraver of The Royal Mint, has had a prolific career at The Royal Mint spanning more than three decades and has served as the Chief Engraver since May 2008. In speaking about his collaboration on the Britannia and Liberty coin series, he remarked: “It was brilliant working with [Joseph Menna] – a really fantastic experience and something completely unique to me in that I often manage teams and guide designers and craftspeople in their work, but I’ve never worked with a peer in equal tandem on a project like this.”

John Bergdahl. John Bergdahl is an experienced coinage artist who has created several designs for United Kingdom coins and medals including a commemorative equestrian portrait of Her Late Majesty Queen Elizabeth II in 2022, as well as the reverse design for the 2023 Coronation of His Majesty King Charles III gold and silver bullion coins. Speaking of his work at The Royal Mint, John explains: “As with all such projects that involve the members of the Royal Family, I look forward to my work being seen and appreciated at the highest levels of society.”

Martin Jennings. Martin Jennings is a celebrated sculptor recognized for his representations of poets, writers, doctors, politicians, and others. Regarding his new effigy of King Charles III, Jennings remarked: “It is a privilege to sculpt the first official effigy of His Majesty and to receive his personal approval for the design. The portrait was sculpted from a photograph of The King, and was inspired by the iconic effigies that have graced Britain’s coins over the centuries. It is the smallest work I have created, but it is humbling to know it will be seen and held by people around the world for centuries to come.”

Philip Nathan. Philip Nathan, a British sculptor and designer, has made significant contributions to the world of medals and coins. His career began at The Royal Mint, where he served as an engraver and designer from 1965 to 1968. Following this, he joined the prolific Franklin Mint in the United States, where he held the position of senior sculptor and designer from 1968 to 1973. Eventually, Nathan returned to his home country, England. While Nathan’s talent and artistry are evident across many noteworthy numismatic creations, he is most recognized for crafting the definitive design for the Britannia range of bullion coins.



John Mercanti. John Mercanti was born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania in April 1943 and went on to build a long and influential career with the United States Mint that spanned more than 35 years. After studying at several Philadelphia-based arts schools, he joined the Mint in 1974 as a sculptor-engraver. He later went on to serve as Chief Engraver from May 2006 until his retirement in 2010. During this career, he was responsible for more coin and medal designs than any other employee in United States Mint history. He designed several commemorative Mint issues in the 1980s and 1990s including the 1986 Statue of Liberty dollar coin and the 1991 Korean War Memorial dollar. He also designed five coins for the 50 State Quarters Program that ran from 1999 until 2008. Perhaps his most influential contribution to American coinage is his majestic Heraldic eagle design featured on the reverse of the American Silver Eagle coin released in 1986. Though retired, Mercanti is still held in high regard among collectors and was named one of the Most Influential People in Numismatics by *Coin World* magazine in 2021.

Joe Menna. Joe Menna is an innovative and accomplished artist and sculptor who first joined the United States Mint in 2005 and was appointed as the 13th Chief Engraver in 2019 by then-Director David Ryder. Menna studied at a number of well-regarded institutions including the University of the Arts in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, the New York Academy of Art, The Stieglitz State Academy of Art and Design in St. Petersburg, Russia, the Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Art, and the Art Students League in New York. He also worked as an instructor and sculptor at the Johnson Atelier Fine Art Foundry in Mercer County, New Jersey. Upon joining the Mint in 2005, he was the first full-time digitally skilled artist hired by the United States Mint and was critical to the development of the first digitally sculpted coins, a technique introduced by the Mint in 2006. Menna's design and sculpting work has been featured on over 60 coins and medals across the past two decades, including the 50 State Quarters Program, the America the Beautiful Quarters Program, the Lincoln Bicentennial One-Cent Coin, the First Spouse Gold Coin and Medal Program, the Native American \$1 Coin, the Presidential \$1 Coins, and many others. For the 35th Anniversary of the American Eagle series, Menna oversaw the transition from the classic designs introduced in 1986 to the refreshed obverse and entirely new reverse designs introduced in 2021.
